#### To Apply for Admission:

- Fill out and the application form on-line at <http://www.applyweb.com/apply/ukansg/>
  - You will be paying an Application processing fee payable to the University of Kansas:
  - The fee schedule is: \$45 online domestic, \$55 paper domestic, \$55 online international, and \$65 paper international.
- Send *this* graduate application checklist to the **KU BioE Office**.
- Send your statement of academic objectives, indicating your first and second (optional) bioengineering track of interest, to the **KU BioE Office**.
- Request that *one* copy of your Official College Transcripts for all undergraduate and graduate coursework be sent to the **KU BioE Office**.
- Request that three letters of recommendation for graduate school, each with a completed recommendation form, be sent to the **KU BioE Office**.
- Request that an original copy of your Graduate Record Exam (GRE) (The institution code for KU is 6871, the program/department code is 1603), Medical College Admission Test (MCAT), or Dental Admission Test (DAT) scores be sent to the **KU BioE Office**.

#### If you are an International Student:

- Request an official copy of your TOEFL scores to be sent to the **KU BioE Office**. (This is a requirement for all students whose native language is not English, unless he/she has a degree from an accredited U.S. institution of higher education)
- Send a financial statement to **KU BioE Office**. The U.S. Department of State mandates that evidence of financial resources, such as an official bank statement, be provided in order to issue an I-20 and student visa.
